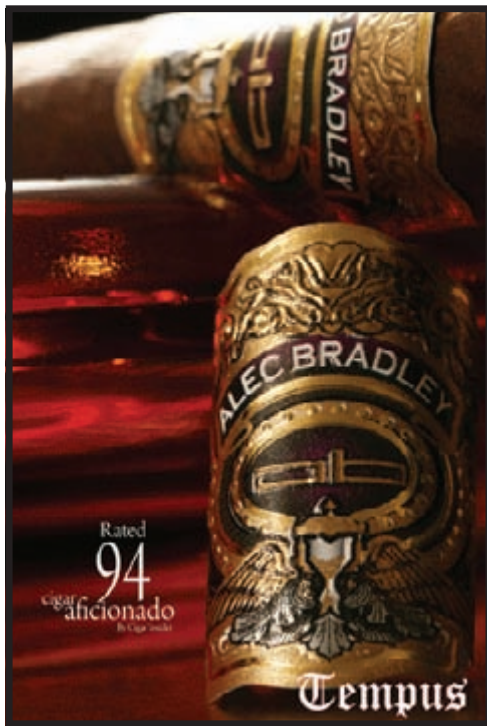

### BEST WAY TO AVOID A PARKING TICKET ON FORT MYERS BEACH

The Trolley

Anyone who's visited Fort Myers Beach on a busy weekend knows parking can be a nightmare. Even if you manage to nab one of the metered spots, chances are you're in violation of one of the island's many parking regulations. Because nothing ruins a day at the beach faster than a \$75 ticket, skip the hassle and take the trolley instead. Park-and-ride lots are at the foot of the bridge or, if you don't feel like driving that far, at Summerlin Square at the corner of Summerlin Road and San Carlos Boulevard. At 50 cents a ride, the trolley beats a parking ticket any day.

### BEST HIKING TRAIL

Six Mile Cypress Slough

Set off Six Mile Cypress Parkway a mile and half north of Daniels Parkway, Six Mile Cypress Slough offers more than a mile of mucky hiking fun. Wear old sneakers and bring a change of clothes, because chances are you're going to get wet. A natural drainage area for a 33-square-mile watershed, the slough winds through cypress stands and precious wetlands. On the guided tours, visitors have a chance to see what Lee County looked like before rampant development and unrestricted growth destroyed the area's natural places.
