The unknown suspect is described as a heavyset, Mexican American (possibly second generation) woman with long, straight, black hair. English may be her first language.

Explorer Sport circa 1998 to 2003, with peeling window tint, who may or may not have been headed to Tampa/St. Petersburg or Miami with baby dos Santos-Gomes.

Another clue to her identity, and therefore perhaps her whereabouts, is the surreal, hypothetical drawing of her face.

While the drawing may look something like the suspected kidnapper, it may also look something like a lot of people who happen to be female, Spanish, heavyset and in their mid 20s. Police said the point of the drawing is to keep the public interested — to give people something to look for, if for no other reason than just so they'll keep looking.

Bryan dos Santos-Gomes' parents, Ramos dos Santos and Gomes Costa, continue to live in the Tropical Trailer Park on Linhart Avenue in central Fort Myers. ■
