Passport Fair takes place Saturday

On Saturday, May 30, the Page Field Post Office, 2655 N. Airport Road, Fort Myers, will again offer a passport fair for individuals needing an original or renewal passport. No appointments will be taken and individuals will be served on a first-come, first-served basis from noon until 3 p.m.

Effective June 1, the last phase of the Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative will go into effect. A passport, passport card, or acceptable documentation will be needed for land border crossings and sea travel. The passport fair will offer passport photos and processing

of new passport applications as well as passport renewals.

Everyone, including newborn infants, is required to obtain a passport in his or her own name. For children under 16, the consent of both parents/guardians is required. A new passport card has been introduced and facilitates entry at U.S. land and sea ports of entry when arriving from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Bermuda; however, it may not be used to travel by air.

Talking openly and honestly with your child regarding gun safety is usually more effective than just ordering him or her to "Stay out of the gun closet." Explaining the rules and answering your child's questions will help remove the mystery surrounding guns. Any rules set for your child should also apply to friends who visit the home.

Teach children if they find a gun: stop, don't touch, leave the area, and tell an adult.

To ensure a safe home environment for your family:

- Store the gun unloaded. This includes the chamber, so look twice and make sure it is unloaded. Most accidental shootings occur because the person involved thought the gun was unloaded.
- Lock the gun and keep it out of reach of children

- Lock the ammunition and store it apart from the gun

- Store keys that you use to lock up the gun separately from household keys

- Make sure keys are kept out of the reach of children

BB guns are not toys and it is very easy to injure or even kill. Here are some important BB gun safety rules:

- Treat all guns as though they are loaded

- Never point your BB gun at anyone
- Check out local and federal laws and regulations

- Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire

- Do not fire the gun unless you know everything around the target

- BBs can ricochet. Be aware of the type of surface at which you are shooting. BBs can ricochet off of flat surfaces, hard surfaces and water.

- Do not allow minors to shoot any type of gun without direct adult supervision.

- Take a gun safety class. ■
