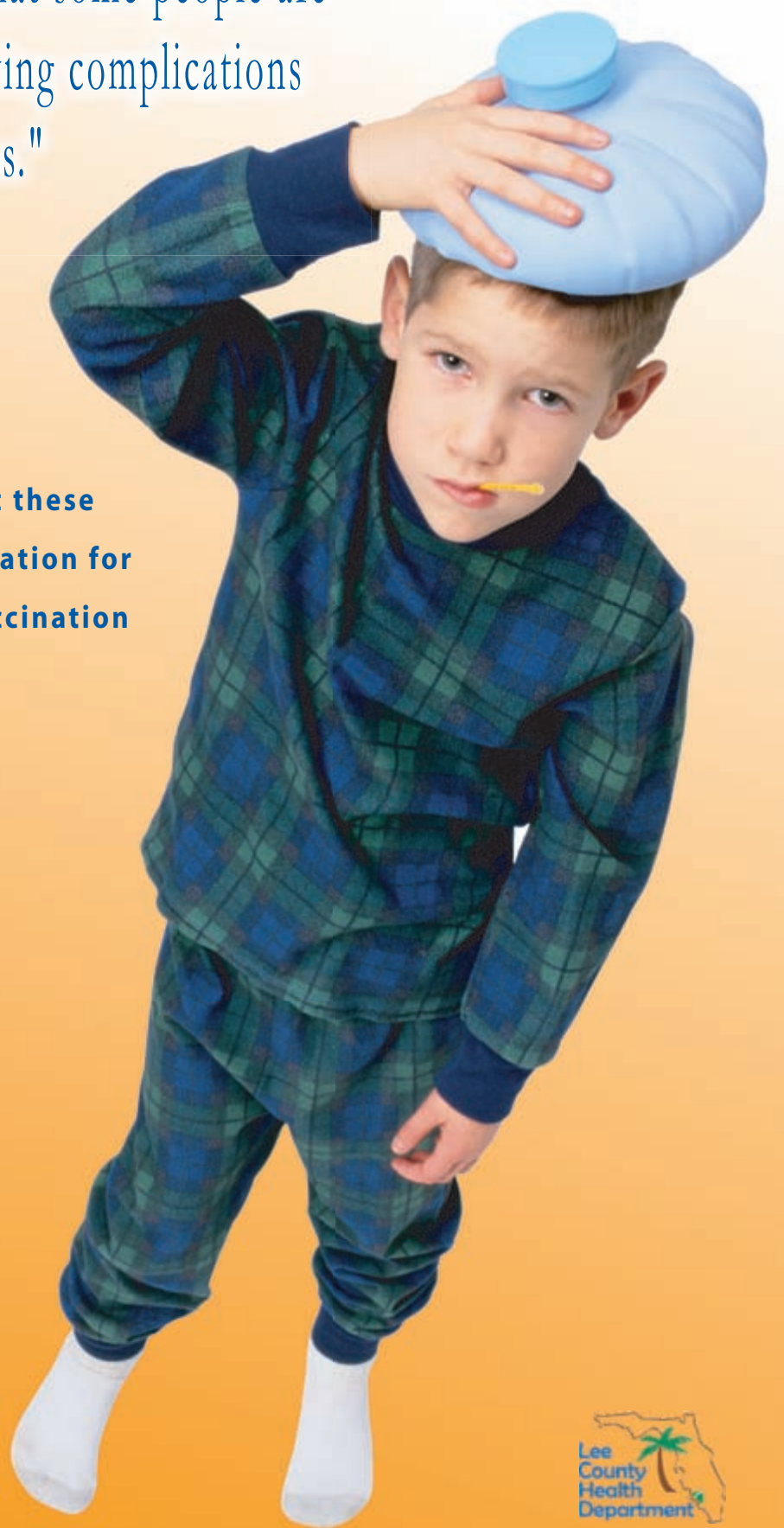
"Medical Experts have determined that some people are at higher risk of contracting or having complications from the H1N1 virus."

- * People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months old
- * Health care workers and emergency medical services personnel
